San Francisco, CA – April 08, 2010 - The Defense Advanced Research Projects Agency (DARPA) has awarded Lockheed Martin Simulation, Training & Support Phase 2 of the National Cyber Range (NCR) program. NCR will provide an environment to develop, field and test new concepts and technologies to protect the United States against growing cyber threats. Promia is a subcontractor to Lockheed Martin providing cyber security knowledge, information assurance and application development expertise.

Promia developed in close cooperation with the U.S. Navy the Intelligent Agent Security Manager (IASM) network security appliance, which is now deployed at U.S. Department of Defense sites worldwide.
